College of Education students pursuing the secondary education major without teacher certification, who have completed 60 semester hours towards their UK degree with a minimum 2.5 GPA, must be admitted to advanced standing. Part of being admitted to advanced standing is to meet with the appropriate advisor, to discuss the course schedule for the upcoming semester, and to secure the advisor's signature on the attached form. Prior to seeing an advisor, students should print out a copy of their unofficial transcript from myUK.

Once a student has returned the attached form to Academic Services and Teacher Certification, 166 Taylor Education Building, his/her advisor will be reassigned, and the student will see his/her newly assigned advisor at the next priority advising period. At the next advising period, the student's Advisor Hold will be lifted by the Department of Curriculum and Instruction following the completion of an advising session. (*Transfer and readmission students who have 60 or more hours and a minimum 2.5 GPA must apply for advanced standing prior to their first on-campus registration period.*)
