### JANUARY

- 2-5 Add/Drop for registered students
- 2-7 Registration for new program graduate students
- 3-7 Registration for new post-baccalaureate students
- 7 Advising Conference and Registration for new freshmen and transfer students including registration for Evening and Weekend**
- 7-8 Opening-of-term add/drop for registered students
- 8 Advising Conference and Registration for readmission, and non-degree students including registration for Evening/Weekend**
- 8 Last day a student may officially drop a course or cancel registration with the Registrar for a full refund of fees
- 8 Student Teaching Orientation (TEB Auditorium)
- 9 First day of classes
- 9-15 Late registration for returning students who did not priority register and new applicants cleared late for admission. A late fee is assessed for students who register during this time period.
- 9 (through Feb 24) Approved time period for students to change academic majors**
- 15 Last day to add a class for the 2008 Spring Semester; Last day to officially withdraw from the University or reduce course load and receive an 80 percent refund
- 21 Martin Luther King, Jr. Birthday - Academic Holiday
- 23 Spring 2007 TEP applications due in TEB 166 (All documentation required)**
- 30 Last day to drop a course without it appearing on the student's transcript; Last day to change grading option (pass/fail to letter grade or letter grade to pass/fail; credit to audit or audit to credit)

### FEBRUARY

- 1 Deadline for applying to the MIC program (305 DH)
- 4-8 Sign-up period for TEP interviews (check with program faculty for exact sign-up dates/locations)**
- 6 Last day to officially withdraw from the University or reduce course load and receive a 50 percent refund
- 7 Last day for filing an application for a May degree in TEB 166 (for undergraduate students)**
- 11-22 **TEP interviews (Please check with program faculty about where and when to sign up for interviews)**
- 14 Registration deadline for March 15 PRAXIS - All tests
- 25 Faculty response forms due in TEB 166**
- 25 (through April 16) Students are prohibited from changing academic majors**

### MARCH

- 3 Results of TEP interviews available from TEB 166**
- 3 Midterm of 2008 Spring Semester
- 7 Last day to withdraw from the University or reduce course load. Students can withdraw or reduce course load after this date only for "urgent non-academic reasons."
- 10-15 Spring Vacation - Academic Holiday
- 24 (through April 16) Priority registration for the 2008 Fall Semester and both 2008 Summer Sessions; COST apps. and Sp '09 Student Teaching apps. accepted during this time**
- 28 Last day for full-time first-time freshmen to withdraw from the University or reduce course load upon approval from their advisor**

### APRIL

- 3 Deadline for receipt of appeal of TEP admissions decisions by Program Faculty**
- 7 Deadline for applying for admission to a program in The Graduate School for the 2007 Summer Sessions. Applications for readmission, post-baccalaureate status, and visiting student status will be accepted after the deadline
- 22 Deadline for applying to The Graduate School for readmission, post-baccalaureate status, and visiting student status for the 2008 4-Week Intersession
- 25 Last day of classes
- 28 (through May 2) Final Examinations
- 29 (through May 5) 4-Week Intersession registration and add/drop continue for students enrolled in Sp '08 semester
- 29 (through June 4) 8-Week Summer Session registration and add/drop continues for students enrolled in Sp '08 semester
- 29 (through June 14) Add/Drop for priority registered students for the 2008 Fall Semester

- 5 Final deadline for submission of grades to Registrar's Office by 4:00 pm
